## Minor in EES (15 credits) (effective Fall semester, 2009)

Our minor is designed for students wishing to explore an area of Earth or Environmental Sciences in conjunction with a major program in another field. You might choose to do this for career enhancement or for personal development. This minor would pair up well with a B.A. major in Environmental Studies.

The requirements for the minor in EES are simple. You need to earn a total of 15 credits in EES, with one credit coming from the integrated introductory laboratory (EES 22), and 8 of the 15 credits coming from EES courses at the 100 or higher levels. In practice, EES 22 requires any one of our introductory-level EES "gateway" courses as a prerequisite or corequisite, so a complete listing of the minor requirements would be:

- 1. Take any introductory-level EES course for three credits.
- 2. Take the EES integrated introductory laboratory (EES 22) for one credit.
- 3. Take 8 credits of EES coursework at the 100-level or above.
- 4. Take additional EES coursework to bring your total of EES credits up to at least 15 credits.

*Note:* EES College Seminars (EES 90) that are designated as natural science (NS) do count towards the minor.
